Good evening! This is \_\_\_\_\_ Net Control Station, this evening, for the ARES District Three Emergency Services Net - serving Grays Harbor, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, and Thurston Counties, and the City of Centralia. This Net meets weekly on the 145.47 repeater at 1915 hours Local. In the event of Repeater Failure, the net will move to the 444.950 repeater, then 3.987 lower sideband.

The purpose of this net is to coordinate the activities of Public Service and Emergency Communications via ARES within this district. This is a directed net; all stations checking in, please use your full call sign for recognition by Net Control, using internationally recognized standard phonetics. During an actual EMERGENCY, a district Operations Net will be established on this frequency to expedite and coordinate Amateur Radio communications and logistics within this District - and with the Washington State Department of Emergency Management.

This net will yield the frequency to emergency or priority traffic at any time.
